



1982-83 AIR FORCE FOOTBALL TEAMS

The heralded 1982-83 Falcon gridiron teams compiled an 18-7-0 mark that included wins in the 1982 Hall of Fame Bowl over Vanderbilt, 36-28, and the 1983 Independence Bowl over Mississippi, 9-3. Coach Ken Hatfield's Falcon teams defeated Army and Navy in both campaigns and beat Notre Dame twice by scores of 30-17 and 23-22.

Marty Louthan, who ran for 1,860 career yards and 4,997 total yards and scored five touchdowns against Navy in 1983, quarterbacked both teams. Fullback John Kershner ran for 1,990 yards during the two seasons as the Falcons averaged almost 300 yards per game running the football.

Current head coach Fisher DeBerry was the offensive coordinator for both squads.
