



## JACK GLAVAN

### SPECIAL RECOGNITION AWARD

Jack Glavan has been vital to the ongoing success of sporting events that rely on the Pikes Peak Highway and its critical role in The Broadmoor Pikes Peak International Hill Climb, Pikes Peak Ascent, Pikes Peak Marathon, The Broadmoor Pikes Peak Cycling Hill Climb and the USA Cycling Hill Climb National Championships.

Born in Sharon, Pennsylvania, Glavan was exposed to automobile racing early. His first job was working in the pit concessions at a quarter-mile dirt track near his hometown, once selling over 100 pounds of hot dogs on a Sunday night!

After graduation from the U.S. Air Force Academy in 1973, he served in the Air Force for 20 years as a navigator and a civil engineer. He began his civil engineering career at McChord AFB before returning to the Air Force Academy as an instructor for the Civil Engineering Department. Glavan is a registered Professional Engineer and has a PhD in Construction Management from the University of Texas.

Glavan joined the Pikes Peak Highway staff in 1995 as the Capital Projects Manager and is currently Manager of the Pikes Peak Highway. During his 21 years on Pikes Peak, he has been instrumental in significant projects including construction of the Crystal Reservoir Visitors Center, renovation of the historic Glen Cove Inn, construction of the new Gateway and the paving of the highway to the summit.

He continues to serve as an advocate for the Pikes Peak Region and Pikes Peak - America's Mountain.
