



THAYER TUTT AWARD RECIPIENT DR. JAMIESON KENNEDY

Dr. Kennedy has gained a cherished reputation over many years by providing critical medical assistance to young athletes in Colorado Springs. He has provided particularly helpful medical coverage during home high school football games for schools and coaching staffs which had limited medical service capabilities, and at the same time persuading many of his colleagues to join him in contributing their time and expertise in years before the role of certified medical trainers became a standard. In addition, Kennedy conducted complete team medical examinations, as well as personal exams for athletes unable to afford those needed services on their own. His selfless efforts also led to the creation of the El Paso Medical Association Society, which provided badly needed medical coverage for area high school teams.

The award is presented annually by the Colorado Springs Sports Corporation to an individual in recognition of exceptional philanthropic and community sports support, as well as on the national sports stage.
