## The Broadmoor Skating Club 1938-2009

Inducted November 10, 2009

Established in 1938 with the opening of the original, iconic Broadmoor Ice Palace on the grounds of the famed hotel, the Broadmoor Skating Club is one of the oldest and most revered clubs in the world. It is famed for producing scores of Olympic, World, Junior World and National Champions and it has embodied excellence at every level and in all skating disciplines. The club's alumni include Olympic Champions Hayes Alan Jenkins, David Jenkins, Peggy Fleming, Colleen O'Connor and Jim Millns; silver medalists Karol and Peter Kennedy; bronze medal winners James Grogan and the Jenkins brothers; and World Champion Jill Trenary and coaching legends Carlo Fassi and Edi Scholdan. The club's venerable Broadmoor World Arena hosted the 1957, 1959, 1965, 1969, and 1975 World Championships, a record for any venue, establishing the city as an international sports hub. In the new Colorado Springs World Arena Ice Halls venue, opened in 1995, the club continues its tradition of developing champions at every level. It has produced over 200 national champions, a mark that continues to grow.
