A 1970 All-American, Ernie Jennings brought both verve and a relaxed confidence to the Air Force Falcons football team. Opponents developed an instant respect for the running back whose soft hands, quick lateral moves and ability to run deep patterns made him nearly impossible to defend.

With the speed and offensive brilliance of Jennings and the finesse of quarterback Bob Parker, the pair formed the most potent passing duo in the country. Jennings and Parker broke school records and set new standards in nearly every game of the 1970 season.

Jennings' talent was recognized when he was nominated for the Heisman Trophy and was later named to the All-American team. He is one of only five consensus All-Americans from the Air Force Academy.
